



## SOUTHERN BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The purpose of these Conditions of Entry is to ensure the enjoyment and safety of all visitors to Southern Basketball Association's (SBA) venues.

### Summary

You must comply with these terms and conditions (**T&Cs**) and must if required follow the reasonable directions of SBA staff, as well as any signage in relation to your entry, exit and use of the premises.

SBA reserves the right to deny entry to or remove any person from its premises at any time.

### Your belongings

You are responsible for the security of your own belongings whilst visiting SBA's premises. You must not:

- Leave any bags or personal items unattended;
- Have in your possession, and/or refuse to surrender to SBA, any prohibited object or article including but not limited to dangerous items or food or alcohol that is not permitted to be brought into or used in SBA's premises.

SBA reserves the right to:

- Inspect and search your bags or belongings while you are on SBA's premises;
- Exclude bags or belongings from SBA premises when deemed appropriate; and
- Deny entry or remove you from the premises (without refund if applicable) if you refuse to comply with these T&Cs.

### Your Behaviour

You are responsible for behaving in a manner that does not interfere with the safety and enjoyment of others. Specifically, you must not behave in a manner:

- that causes or may cause property damage or that threatens or may threaten the safety of players, officials, coaches, administrators, visitors, spectators or any other persons, including as a result of intoxication; or
- that unreasonably interferes with other persons' enjoyment of SBA's premises; or
- which breaches any policy or code of conduct of SBA, Basketball Victoria (BV) or Basketball Australia (BA).

All visitors to SBA's premises are expected to contribute to an environment that upholds the SBA's values. More information can be found at

When you are at SBA's premises, if you experience harassment or feel unsafe, please report it as soon as possible to an SBA member of staff. All reports of harassment, bullying and other inappropriate behaviour will be swiftly investigated in accordance with SBA, BV and/or BA policies and relevant legislation and acted upon as appropriate.



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### Other Responsibilities

You must not:

- Smoke or use e-cigarettes indoors at SBA's premises or outside designated smoking zones;
- Take photographs, audio, or video recording where this has been restricted;
- Consume food or drink (including alcohol) purchased outside the premises, unless otherwise indicated;
- Purchase or consume alcohol at or on the premises unless you are 18 years of age or older;
- Enter or gain access to areas of the premises not open to the public, unless authorised by SBA; or
- Bring bicycles, motorcycles, motorised/electric scooters or segways into SBA's premises without the express permission of SBA.

### Children under the age of 15

Children under the age of 15 must be under the supervision of a responsible adult (18 years of age or older) at all times.

### Use of your image

You acknowledge that SBA has cameras and/or other recording equipment on each court and that SBA will or may record every game played at SBA's premises. You consent to and authorise SBA or persons delegated by it to film, record or photograph games and/or you (**Recording**), and to reproduce Recordings in any audio, video, or photographic display or other transmission, exhibition, publication or reproduction in any medium or context to promote SBA's objects and activities without further authorisation by, or compensation or attribution to you. All Recordings are the sole property of SBA or its third parties and by entering SBA's premises you release SBA from liability arising on account of such usage. Security cameras operate on and at SBA's Premises and you acknowledge that you may be filmed.

### Admission

SBA reserves the right to:

- charge a fee for admission to its premises and
- impose additional terms and conditions in respect to admission to its premises.



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### Liability

You enter SBA's Premises at your own risk. To the maximum extent permitted by law, SBA will not be responsible for any loss, damage, harm or injury arising from your entry to the premises.

### Other Conditions

These T&Cs prevail in the event of inconsistency with any specific conditions which may apply to certain events.

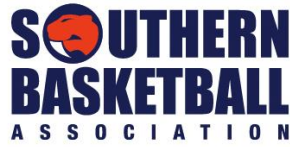
### COVID-19 Special Conditions

SBA is committed to the safety of staff, visitors, players and officials. To ensure your safety SBA has adopted some special Conditions that respond to the global coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Should there be any inconsistency between these special conditions and other published Terms and Conditions, these special terms will apply.

1. In accordance with health guidelines, SBA may require transaction payments to be completed using contactless payments. Cash payments may not be accepted for some or all transactions.
2. You must not attend SBA's premises or any event at those premises if you are required to be in isolation with a COVID-19 diagnosis or have been directed to be in quarantine because of close contact with a person with COVID-19 or if you are experiencing any of symptoms of COVID-19.
3. All visitors to SBA's premises must comply with any COVID-19 safety protocols or requirements communicated to you by SBA (including signage at the venue or floor line markings). This includes complying with:
  - Hand hygiene requirements;
  - Physical distancing requirements (including physical spacing requirements while queuing);
  - Mask and personal protective equipment directives;
  - Person limits for each space or area; or
  - Person density/capacity requirements.

You acknowledge that anyone not adhering to these requirements may be in breach of directions issued by the Chief Health Officer Victoria for which penalties may apply.

4. You acknowledge that prior or after entry SBA may be required to collect contact tracing information from you and each member of your party when you visit SBA's premises for any reason.



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5. You agree to provide SBA with any information it is required to collect for contact tracing purposes. The purpose of collecting this information is to assist any contact tracing in the event of an outbreak or potential exposure to someone with COVID-19 at SBA's premises. You acknowledge that we may disclose contact tracing information to health authorities or as otherwise required or authorised by law. You acknowledge that SBA may retain the information for 28 days (or such longer period as required by law), after which time it will be deleted or destroyed. While we hold the information, we will take all reasonable steps to keep your contact tracing information secure and free from unauthorised access or use.
6. You may be refused entry or required to leave SBA's premises or an event if you:
  - Refuse to comply with any COVID-19 safety protocols or requirements notified to you by SBA.
  - Refuse to comply with any reasonable health and safety directions given by SBA staff.
  - Refuse to provide contact tracing information to SBA on request.
  - Are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, as notified to or as assessed by SBA. These include fever, chills or sweats, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose or loss of sense of smell.
  - Are required to be in isolation as a result of COVID-19 diagnosis or have been directed to be in quarantine because of close contact with a person with COVID-19.
7. We ask that every visitor make a reasonable assessment of their health status before attending SBA's premises.
8. You must notify SBA immediately if you develop any symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days of attending SBA premises. Please contact us immediately.
